

## PRIVACY ADDENDUM FOR MINORS

According to Oregon State Law, you are legally able to ask for and receive medical treatment without your parent's consent or knowledge as soon as you are fifteen years old. However, if we bill your parent's health insurance or your parents directly, they will know you have been seen in our office. You also have the right to keep your medical treatment results (lab work, etc.) confidential from your parents. We need to know what information, if any, you want your parent to have.
